The principal parts (pp) for this IRREGULAR verb are:

Notice there is no -re in the 2nd principal part as we have seen with verbs from the 1st and 2nd conjugations.

To form this verb there are no "steps". You just have to memorize the forms and translations Please note these are not endings. They are words that stand by themselves in a sentence.
