3rd declension I-stem Nouns

- There are only a few places where these nouns are different from regular 3rd declension
- In the **masculine and feminine** the only form that is different is the **genitive plural**
- In the neuter there are four places: ablative singular, nominative plural, accusative plural and genitive plural

Here are the charts for the 3rd declension I-stem nouns
