

Vocabulary for 5th declension

dies, diei m.	day
acies, aciei	battleline, battle formation
res, rei	matter, affair, thing, fact etc.
facies, faciei	appearance
spes, spei	hope
fides, fidei	trust, belief, faith
species, speciei	show, sight, appearance

the word *res* takes on many different meanings depending on the context. The following are some examples of the different meanings it can have.

res publica=public
 res novae=revolution
 res gestae=accomplishments

The word *res* will be declined using 5th decl. endings, but the words *publica*, *novae*, *gestae*, will use 1st decl. fem. adjective endings because they are adjectives modifying *res*. So the word *republic* in the accusative case would look like this
rem publicam
