

Ablative of time – translate the word relating to time by supplying  
“in, on, at, during, within”

Accusative of time – translate the word relating to time by supplying “for”

examples: *Servi horas multas laborabant* – the slaves were working for many hours.  
accusative of time horas multas

*Nocte servi multi fugerunt* – during the night many slaves escaped.  
ablative of time – nocte
