To figure out the direct object find the verb and ask “who or what is being verbed.”

To figure out the indirect object ask “to or for whom the verb is being done” or ask “who is receiving the direct object”

### INDIRECT OBJECT

1. To whom are the presents being given?
2. For whom are the meals being prepared?

3. Who will get the card
4. Who got the news
5. Who got the money
