Nota bene: Some verbs are irregular and have irregular infinitive forms in the the present active. Here is a list of some of these verbs.

sum, esse, fui, futurus – be possum, posse, potui, ---- - be able fero, ferre, tuli, latum – bring, bear, carry volo, velle, volui,---- - wish, be willing nolo, nolle, nolui, ---- - not wish, be unwilling malo, malle, malui, ---- - prefer eo, ire, ivi, itum – go

Please be extra careful with esse:

- alone it is a present active infinitive form of *sum*
- with the 4<sup>th</sup> principal part it is part of the perfect passive infinitive of all verbs
- with the future active participle it is the future infinitive of all verbs

Credidi Herculem esse fortem – I believe Hercules is strong Credidi Herculem captum esse – I believe Hercules has been captured Credidi Herculem capturum esse hostem – I believe Hercules will capture the enemy
