

Interrogatives to MEMORIZE

quis-who (only as the nominative, singular, subject)

quid-what (only as either nominative, singular, subject or accusative, singular, direct object)

cuius-whose (singular)

quorum-whose (plural)

cui – to/for whom (singular)

quem – whom (only as direct object or object of preposition)

ubi – when

ubi where (at)

cur – why

quo modo – how (in what way)

quo – where (to)

unde - where (from)

Examples for the ones that have cases:

Quis pecuniam cepit – Who stole the money?

Cuius pecunia capta est – Whose money was stolen?

Quorum pecuniam capta est Whose money has been stolen?

Cui pecuniam dedisti – To whom did you give the money? or

Whom did you give the money (to)?

Quem in viā viderunt – Whom did they see on the road?
