The forms of *sum*, *esse*, *fui*, *futurus* are used as linking verbs. Linking verbs JOIN nouns or pronouns to nouns, adjectives or prepositional phrases

Examples:

sum laeta – i am happy milites erant fortes – the soldiers were strong Iulius Caesar erat dux – Julius Caesar was the leader erimus ad arborem – we will be near the tree

Do NOT use these verb forms to express the **present**, **imperfect** or **future** tenses of **ACTION** verbs

Est ambulat – the est is not needed here

ambulat all by itself is translated as she is walking, she walks or she does walk
