iubes-you order

iubebas-you were ordering

iubebis-you will order

iussisti-you did order

pugno, pugnare, pugnavi, pugnatum- 1<sup>st</sup> person pl

pugnamus-we fight

pugnabamus-we were fighting

pugnabimus-we will fight

pugnavimus-we did fight

pugnaveramus-we had fought

pugnaverimus-we will have fought

cedo, cedere, cessi, cessum – move, yield 2<sup>nd</sup> person pl.

ceditis-you move

cedebatis – you were moving

cedetis – you will move

cessistis – you did move

cesseratis – you had moved

cesseritis – you will have moved

habitant - they live

habitabant – they were living

habitabunt – they will live

habitaverunt – they did live

habitaverant – they had lived

habitaverint – they will have lived

sedeo, sedere, sedui, seditum 2<sup>nd</sup> sing

sedes-you sit

sedebas – you were sitting

sedebis – you will sit

seduisti – you did sit

sedueras – you had sat

sedueris – you will have sat

rego, regere, rexi, rectus 3<sup>rd</sup> singular

regit-she rules

regebat-she was ruling

reget-she will rule

rexit- she did rule

rexerat- she had ruled

rexerit – she will have ruled
