Present Tense

imperfect tense

eram– I was	eramus - we were

erat – she was , etc	erant – they were, etc

future tense

ero– I will be	erimus - we will be
eris – you will be	eritis – you will be
erit – it will be , etc	erunt – they will be, etc.

imperfect tense

<b>poteram– I was able</b>	<b>poteramus - we were able</b>

future tense

<b>potero– I will be able</b>	<b>poterimus - we will be able</b>
