NOTA BENE! (Note well!)

- When nouns are listed in the vocabulary, you are always given the nominative singular form and then the genitive singular.
- The 2nd form listed is the genitive singular and it is how you get the BASE of the noun.
- TO GET THE BASE TAKE THE GENITIVE SINGULAR FORM AND DROP THE GENITIVE SINGULAR ENDING. In the second declension the genitive singular ending is *-i*
